1. Recipient **must be a graduate of Hancock County High School.**
2. Recipient must be a freshman or sophomore at OCTC who plans to transfer to WKU Owensboro upon completion of the Associate's Degree.
3. Recipient must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
4. The recipient must have a 2.0 grade point average.
5. The scholarship is based on tuition fees of up to \$164 per credit hour.
6. Recipient may be full-time (12 hours or more) or part-time (at least 3 hours) at OCTC.
7. Financial need is to be an important consideration.
8. The award is not automatically renewable but recipients can re-apply for consideration in future years.
9. Recipients will be selected by the OCTC Scholarship Committee.
10. Recipients must possess the personal qualities of character, integrity, dependability, industriousness and human compassion which produce leaders and merit the honor of the award.
11. Applicants must complete an OCTC Scholarship Application **no later than April 1** prior to the academic year for which the individual is applying.
12. Preference will be given to students who are jointly admitted to both OCTC and WKU-O.
