The Healthcare Facilities Foundation (HFF) Certificate provides students with the foundational elements to build upon for a career in the challenging field of healthcare facility management. This certificate is an integral part of the HFL degree program. The HFF certificate will cover:

- + The dynamics and language of a healthcare facility
- + The physical environment of healthcare
- + Facility management systems
- + Accreditation
- + Energy management
- + Life safety, OSHA, NFPA, & other regulatory requirements
- + Infection prevention and control

Students earning a HFF Certificate will have a strong foundation to gain employment in healthcare facilities services, and to position themselves for advancement into a leadership role.

Hiring managers surveyed indicated those with some practical trade experience and the HFF certificate could expect a starting salary between \$30,000 to \$45,000 . Salaries vary by region and state.
