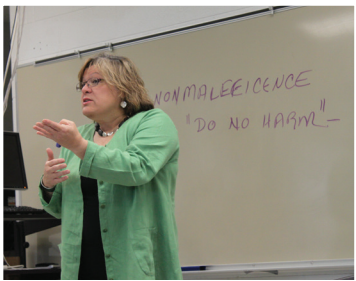


### Job Outlook
