Job Outlook

Job prospects are excellent as medical records management is one of the fastest growing occupations in the exciting field of healthcare. The average annual salary for a medical records and health

information technicians in Kentucky is \$32,411.* Wages vary and may be significantly higher than the average depending on the area of specialty.
