

VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY



Candidates for admission must have a high school diploma or GED and must be admitted to OCTC before being considered for admission to the program.

The following items must be on file in the Admissions office:

1. Completed Application for Admission to OCTC
2. Official transcripts from: High school (a partial transcript is acceptable for seniors prior to graduation) and all colleges attended.
3. Completion of testing and test results sent to OCTC. ACT/SAT scores and placement test scores, if required.

Admission Requirements of the Veterinary Technology Program

1. Students applying to the program must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 to be eligible.
2. Applicants must have an ACT composite score of 20 or above.
3. Complete all Veterinary Technology Program application forms.
4. Complete a formal personal interview with the Veterinary Technology admissions committee. Applicants are evaluated during the interview process based on the following criteria: academic ability, previous experience, reasoning and critical thinking skills, professional appearance, personal interaction skills, and motivation.
5. Complete an eight-hour observation of the activities and duties of a licensed veterinary technician. Verification form to be signed by licensed technician or veterinarian.
6. Report, in writing, any felony convictions.
7. Review completely the Veterinary Technology Program Student Policy Manual, available on the OCTC website and in the library, prior to being admitted into the Veterinary Technology Program.
8. Complete all Transitional Education requirements in reading, writing, and math as indicated by the institutional placement guidelines (ACT or COMPASS) by the end of the Spring semester prior to enrolling in Veterinary Technology classes for the Fall semester.



Completion of these requirements certifies eligibility, but in no way implies or guarantees admission to the program. Due to accreditation requirements and facility constraints class size is limited.
