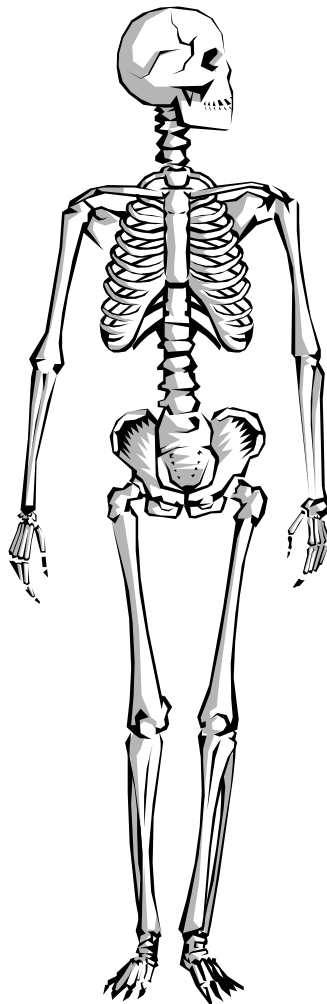

RADIOGRAPHY APPLICATION PROCEDURE **CHECKLIST**

Submit to the **Student Records Office** in the Campus Center

- If you are not currently enrolled at a KCTCS college, complete a OCTC College Admission Application. Forms are available at the Start center. You must complete ALL items on the application.

- If you have attended a non-KCTCS college, have an official college transcript sent. All college transcripts must be sent directly from the College or University to:

If you already have official transcripts on file, you do not need to obtain duplicates.

- Verify with the Student Records Office that your major is AS with student group code OWRT. (Radiography Pending)

- Ensure that official results of your ACT (**Strongly preferred**), or SAT, or COMPASS are on file in the office of the Registrar by **March 1st**. **These are not usually on your transcript from another college. You must make sure that student records have an official ACT scores. Failure to do so will disqualify your application.**

- Submit the “Statement of Intention to Enroll” (form attached)
- Write a short essay explaining why Radiography is your career of choice and why the committee should select you over other candidates.
- Submit the signed ASRT Radiography career form.

Note: It is your responsibility to make sure all documents have been received by **March 1. Any student with an incomplete file **WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED** for the incoming Radiography class.**

Radiography Program

3.10.1 System Guidelines

Enrollment in the radiography program may be restricted due to limited laboratory facilities or faculty and financial resources.

Technical Standards

Radiography involves the provision of direct care for individuals and is characterized by the application of verified knowledge in the skillful performance of radiological technical functions. Therefore, all applicants should possess:

1. sufficient visual acuity, such as is needed in the accurate preparation and administration of contrast media and for the observation necessary for patient assessment and nursing care;
2. sufficient auditory perception to receive verbal communication from patients and members of the health team and to assess health needs of people through the use of monitoring devices such as cardiac monitors, stethoscopes, intravenous infusion pumps, fire alarms, etc.;
3. sufficient gross and fine motor coordination to respond promptly and to implement the skills, including the manipulation of equipment, positioning and lifting patients required in meeting health needs related to radiologic technology;

4. sufficient communication skills (speech, reading, writing) to interact with individuals and to communicate their needs promptly and effectively, as may be necessary in the patient's/client's interest; and
5. sufficient intellectual and emotional functions to plan and implement care for individuals.

Each applicant must submit the following by March 1 in order to be considered by the committee:

1. Completed application for admission to the college;
2. Transcripts of all postsecondary education or training;
3. ACT or Compass score reports;

Possible Additional Requirements

1. An individual college may require at least a four hour observation/work experience in a Radiology Department with documentation returned to the college; and
2. An individual college may require an interview or pre-admission conference prior to consideration for admission to the radiography program.

Preference may be given to

1. Applicants with an ACT composite score of 20 or above; or COMPASS scores in Math (Algebra) of 48 or above, in Reading of 81 or above, and in Writing 70 or above;
2. Applicants who have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better (4 point scale) in 10 hours or more of college credit applicable to the radiography program;
3. Applicants who have completed the biological and physical sciences and mathematics courses listed in the radiography curriculum with a grade of "C" or better.

Note: The following requirements will be discussed in the orientation following notice of admission into the Radiography Program:

CPR certification for Healthcare Professionals must be obtained prior to enrolling in RAD 100 and certification must be kept current throughout the program.

Also, after admission and prior to enrollment, each student must show evidence that he/she:

- (a) Has received Hepatitis B vaccination, **or**
- (b) Is in the process of receiving the Hepatitis B vaccine series.
- (c) Has received an acceptable MMR immunization or titer
- (d) Has obtained a TB skin test by the intradermal method

A signed declination form must be submitted if a student chooses not to receive the Hepatitis B vaccination.

The curriculum requires course attendance in fall and spring semesters **and** the summer session.
