

Surgical Technology Program Admission Guidelines:

The Owensboro Community and Technical College Surgical Technology program utilizes six (6) clinical facilities for the program's clinical courses and the student's clinical learning experience. Due to the clinical rotation schedule, the student may not visit all six (6) sites; however, each student must be eligible to attend all six (6) sites. Owensboro Health Regional Hospital (OHRH) is the only clinical site used during first semester clinical rotation, October – December.

In order to attend, and meet program eligibility, students enrolled in the Owensboro Community and Technical College Surgical Technology program are required to meet all policies and regulatory guidelines set forth by each clinical facility, e.g., operating room attire, felony and/or misdemeanor convictions, etc. If a student is found to be ineligible to meet any clinical facility policy and/or regulatory guideline, the student will not be eligible for enrollment in the Owensboro Community and Technical College Surgical Technology program.
